

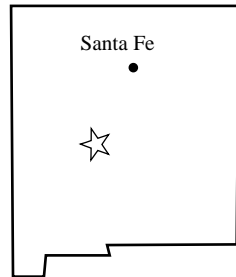
Box Canyon bouldering, New Mexico

Great bouldering, two minutes away from the car. Steep and powerful problems of varying difficulty. Many pockets, cobbles and a few slopers. Good landing. Always one side with shade. How to get there: It is really easy to find. From Socorro take the I-60 west. Shortly after the mile marker 132, park after a small bridge and a canyon to your left. Walk down to the canyon for the first boulders. There is more if you go up the stream.

Continuing West on I-60 for a hundred yards or so past the bridge, you can turn left on the dirt road and access more of Box. There is a lot of good rock there.

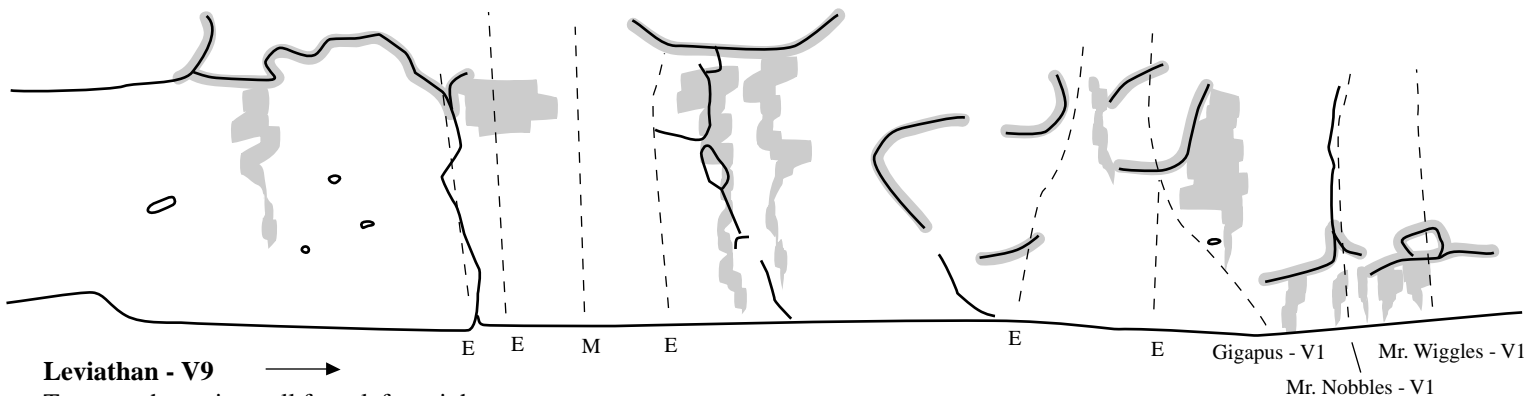
East Streambed
Left Right



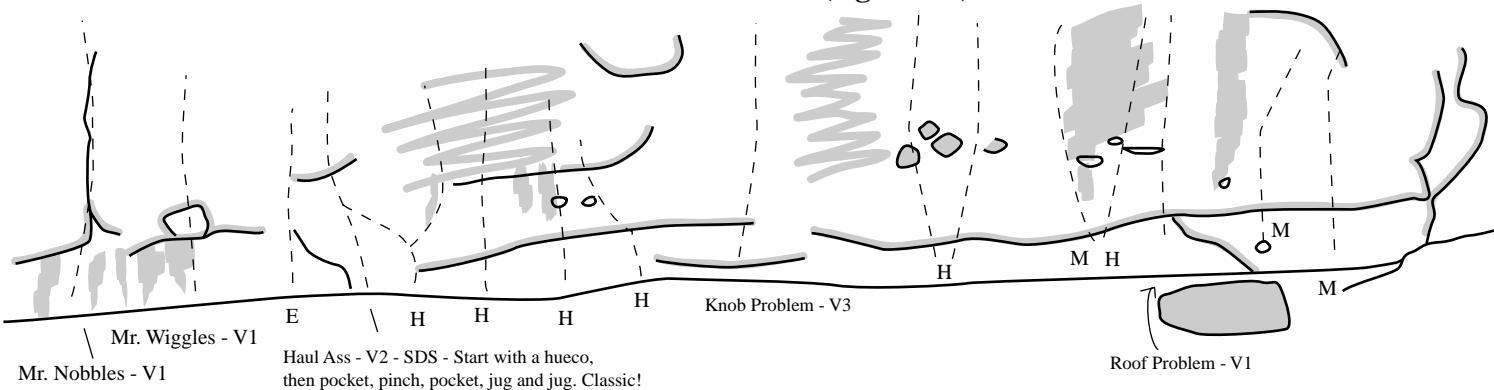
West Streambed
